FIVE SUCCESSIVE BASE REALIGNMENTS AND CLOSURES COMMISSIONS HAVE VALIDATED THE VITAL LINK MCAS MIRAMAR HAS TO OUR FUTURE NATIONAL SECURITY DEMANDS.

2. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CURRENT MARINE CORPS AVIATION PLAN, THE MARINE CORPS WILL FIELD THE MV-22 AND THE JOINT STRIKE FIGHTER (JSF) OVER THE NEXT TWENTY YEARS OR SO. REQUEST YOU DEVELOP LONG TERM PLANS FOR THE BASING OF THOSE AIRCRAFT AT MCAS MIRAMAR. ALL PLANS ARE SUBJECT TO

REVIEW UNDER FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS, BUT FROM A MARINE AVIATION PERSPECTIVE MCAS MIRAMAR IS THE RIGHT PLACE FOR THE JSF AND THE MV-22 TO SUPPORT I MEF.

3. MCAS MIRAMAR OFFERS THE BEST MIX OF CAPABILITY, CAPACITY AND TRAINING IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE OTHER COMPONENTS OF THE MARINE AIR GROUND TASK FORCE; THEREFORE, COMMARFORPAC AND MCI-WEST MUST CONTINUE TO PURSUE PLANS TO BASE THE MV-22 AND THE JSF AT MCAS MIRAMAR.//
