SYNOPSIS:

Kacie Bluhm obstructed uniform officers during the course of their duty, I was necessary to use physical force on Bluhm to take her into physical custody.

I arrested Bluhm for 148(a) (1) PC (Resisting arrest/Obstructing police) and booked her into the Las Colinas Detention Facility.

ORIGIN:

At 0134 hrs Officer Stone #6357 and I responded to 8th Ave and Date Street on a radio call of a domestic violence disturbance (IH #13080004238).

INVESTIGATION:

Officer Stone and I were both dressed in full police uniform and each of us was driving a distinctive black and white SDPD police car equipped with overhead emergency lights.

Officer Stone had civilian ride along [redacted] from the citizens review board with her. [redacted] was dressed in civilian clothes and was wearing a SDPD ride along decal attached to her outer most garment of her shirt.

Officer Stone and I had responded to that location on the radio call domestic violence disturbance at the request of [redacted] had called the police because his daughter and her husband had been involved in an argument and he was unable to locate them. [redacted] was concerned that the argument would escalate to physical violence against his daughter. [redacted] described his son in law to us as being "crazy".

As Officer Stone spoke with [redacted] we concluded that based on the information he provided it was necessary for us to check the welfare of his daughter to ensure she had not been physically assaulted; afraid of her husband, being held against her will or in need of police assistance.

Officer Stone discovered that [redacted] daughter was a resident at [redacted]. Officer Stone and uniformed security guard [redacted] (security from a nearby condominium) approached the main entry of the condominium/apartments called Aloft to enter and make contact with the subjects of the radio call.

The main entry of the condominium/apartments was locked and secure. The onsite security guard was not present and made repeated cell phone calls to him so he could open the door for us. was unable to make contact with the security guard at Aloft via phone or otherwise.

The was no on site manager or HOA board member to allow us inside and there was no entry code that we could use for us to gain access from the callbox.

As we stood at the entrance to the building Kacie Bluhm arrived on scene with a female companion. Bluhm exited the passenger's side of her companion's vehicle and called out to us. Bluhm asked us if we needed access inside. I told her "Yes". Bluhm then asked why we needed access.

I explained to Bluhm that we needed access to the building because we needed to check the welfare of a female resident to ensure that she wasn't in any danger or needed the police.

Bluhm told us "I don't feel comfortable opening the door for people that don't live here; you'll have to call the HOA.

I explained to Bluhm that we were investigating a situation where a resident may be the victim of a crime and may need our assistance. Bluhm's response was, "you'll have to call the HOA to get in. I don't feel comfortable letting a bunch of people in that don't live here."

I told Bluhm "we're not a bunch of people we are the police and we're investigating a potential crime".

Bluhm questioned me as to whether CRB ride-along could enter the building.

Bluhm stood fast refusing to assist us in entering the building.

I explained to Bluhm again that we were there for the sole purpose to investigate a possible crime.

Since it was obvious Bluhm would not assist us Officer Stone and I waited at the buildings entrance for a resident to enter or exit.

As we waited Bluhm approached the building entry and told us that she was going inside. I told Bluhm that I was not preventing her from doing such and I attempted to reason with her in an effort to convince her to assist us.

Bluhm was becoming agitated and angry with me. I had hoped Bluhm would open use her access code to allow us inside, however she would not.

Bluhm told me that she was going inside and entered her code on the wall mounted callbox. Bluhm opened the door and stepped inside. Once she opened the door for herself I grabbed it and stepped into the entryway. Bluhm grabbed the door's interior push bar with both hands and attempted to pull it shut on me. Bluhm was unable to close the door because I was halfway inside the lobby.

I grabbed Bluhm by her left wrist and used my physical strength to pull her grip from the door as I told her "you're under arrest". I pulled Bluhm outside and told her "put your hands behind your back, you're under arrest".

Bluhm refused to comply with my verbal commands and physically resisted by attempting to twist from my grip and by attempting to pull backwards away from me. I held the door open as I repeated my verbal commands multiple times telling Bluhm to "stop resisting, put your hand behind your back".

Bluhm's female companion quickly exited her car and ran up to Bluhm and I as she struggled violently to prevent me from handcuffing her. Bluhm's companion told her repeatedly "calm down, stop fighting". Bluhm would not listen to her companion or my commands.

I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage on Bluhm's breath as I struggled to take her into physical custody.

I used my physical strength to force Bluhm's right hand/wrist behind her back into the handcuffing position. Bluhm continued to violently resist handcuffing by attempting to turn and face me as she violently struggled to free herself from my grasp.

Officer Stone had to assist me by physically placing Bluhm's left hand/wrist behind her back by using her physical strength as she also told her "stop resisting".

I placed a handcuff on Bluhm's right wrist and then did the same on her left wrist with Officer Stone's assistance.

Once handcuffed Bluhm continued with her physical efforts to free herself, I attempted to escort Bluhm to my patrol car but her efforts to resist continued.

I told Bluhm repeatedly "come on, walk". Bluhm would not walk but used her legs in an effort to back away from me to resist walking. Rather than using additional force on her I asked Officer Stone to bring my patrol car to the front of the apartment/condo.

Officer Stone retrieved my patrol car and parked it in the street in front of Aloft.

I again instructed Bluhm to walk towards my patrol car, she failed to comply and protested loudly "what am I being arrested for".

I informed Bluhm that I arrested her for obstructing/resisting the police.

In order to secure Bluhm in the backseat of my patrol car I had to grasp her by her upper left arm and use my physical strength to pull her towards it. Bluhm continued in her efforts to not comply by leaning backwards and locking her knees straight.

I pulled Bluhm to my patrol car, opened the back door and instructed her to get inside however she continued to not cooperate.

A resident at the Aloft condominium/apartments witnessed Bluhm's arrest and demanded I have the SDPD watch commander respond to his location, clearly he was angry at what he had witnessed and felt it was un-necessary.

In order to get Bluhm in the back seat of my patrol car I had to physically push her inside before I could close the door. Once I secured Bluhm in my backseat I requested a field supervisor respond to our location.

Sgt Stinson arrived #5529 on-scene and I informed him of Bluhm's arrest and nature of the initial radio call.

Sgt Stinson spoke to the irate male resident as I transported Bluhm to police Headquarters.

Shortly after taking Bluhm into custody the male and female subject of the domestic violence call exited the apartment/condominiums. Officer Stone spoke to them both, they told her that the argument she had with her husband was verbal only and that no crime had occurred.

Officer Stone documented CRB witness Smith's information as well as security officer Cordell's because they had witnessed the circumstances of the arrest.

Once at Headquarters I prepared Bluhm's booking paperwork and admonished her per my PD 145 Notebook; Bluhm answered "Yes" to both questions.

Bluhm acknowledged that she recognized we were uniformed police officers in response to a call for service at that location and acknowledged that she understood why I was asking for access to the building (for details see her below statement).

I transported Bluhm to Las Colinas and once she was taken into Sherriff's custody I completed her arrest report and prepared an electronic force effectiveness form and submitted it electronically.

BACKGROUND:

Bluhm is a resident of the Aloft Condominium/Apartments located at 889 Date Street. The complex can be accessed when residents enter their numerical pass code on the wall mounted callbox. Bluhm felt it was necessary to deny us entry in the building for the protection of the other residents. Bluhm told me that she didn't know how much alcohol she had consumed.

STATEMENTS:

Statement of Kacie Bluhm: (Suspect)

As a woman who lives here by herself I'm weary to just open the door to let anyone inside the building. I understand now that it was a poor choice for what I did. I took it upon myself to protect the other residents from letting you in and now I realize it was a big mistake.

I understand you were wearing a police uniform and you even told me why you wanted to get inside, I'm sorry. I understand it is your job to protect the people inside my building.

I didn't realize I tried to pull the door closed on you and I did hear you telling me I was under arrest, I just didn't understand why I was being arrested. I made a big mistake.

I would hope that if I were in a situation where the police needed to check on me that a resident would let the police inside.

There isn't any HOA office at the apartment. I just didn't feel comfortable with letting just anyone inside.

I use to live in a building where residents would open the door for just anyone; I took it upon myself to protect them (residents).

I didn't know that you could arrest me. I know you explained it to me but a didn't understand.

OFFICERS REPORT:

On 08-03-13, at 0135 hours, I was dispatched to the intersection of 8th Avenue and Date Street on a possible domestic violence incident (I had a ride-a-long assigned to me for the night, I contacted the reporting party of the incident. The reporting party said his daughter went inside the locked apartment complex to confront her boyfriend. The reporting party said he had not heard from his daughter and was worried about her safety.

Officer Smith (4708) and I tried to gain access to the apartment complex located at 889 Date Street. A resident, Kacie Bluhm, asked us if we needed access to the complex. Officer Smith said yes. Bluhm then said she was not going to let us into the complex. I stayed with Officer Smith and I again contacted the reporting party to try to get keys to the building.

I heard a commotion and saw Officer Smith struggling with Bluhm. I heard Officer Smith tell Bluhm that she was under arrest. I went back to assist Officer Smith. I saw that Bluhm was pulling away from Officer Smith and was flailing her left arm. I used physical force and placed Bluhm's left hand behind her back, by placing my hands on her arm. Officer Smith handcuffed Bluhm.

I took a statement from Latisha Smith.

STATEMENT OF _____ (WITNESS):

Paraphrased

I was a ride-a-long on 08-02-13. I was observing a radio call for a possible domestic violence incident. I was with officers as they were trying to gain access to a locked apartment building. A gray car pulled up to the apartment building and a female resident got out of the car. The female resident tried to get into the apartment by entering her code on the entrance keypad. The female resident wanted to know why police needed to get in the building and then said she was not going to let officers in the building. Officer Smith tried to explain there was a possible emergency in the building and officers needed access. The resident opened the door to the complex and I saw Officer Smith grab the door to keep the door from closing. The resident tried to close the door by pulling the door from the inside. The resident asked what Officer Smith was doing. Officer Smith then told the resident she was under arrest. Officer Smith put his hands on the resident and she tried to pull away multiple times, by moving her body away from Officer Smith.
