### Cost

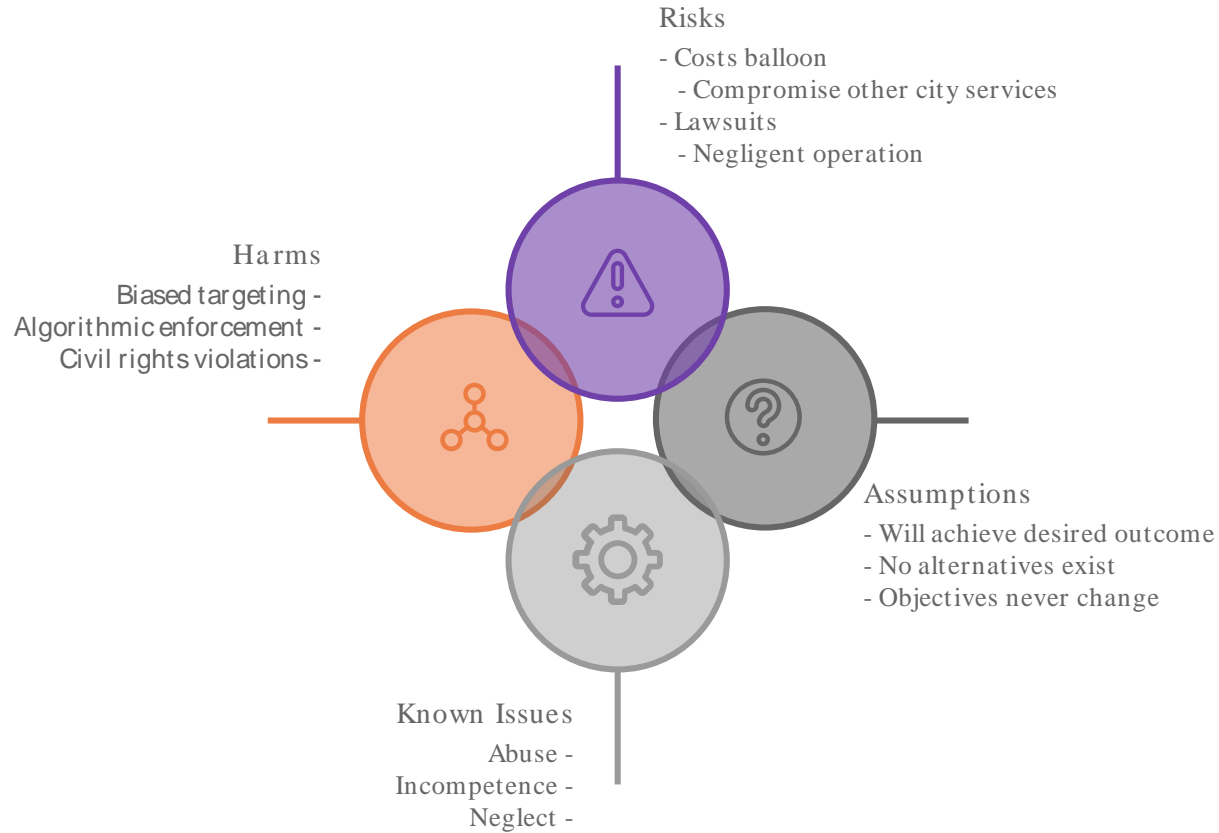
True costs of deployment, calibration, maintenance underestimated

No ongoing review required.

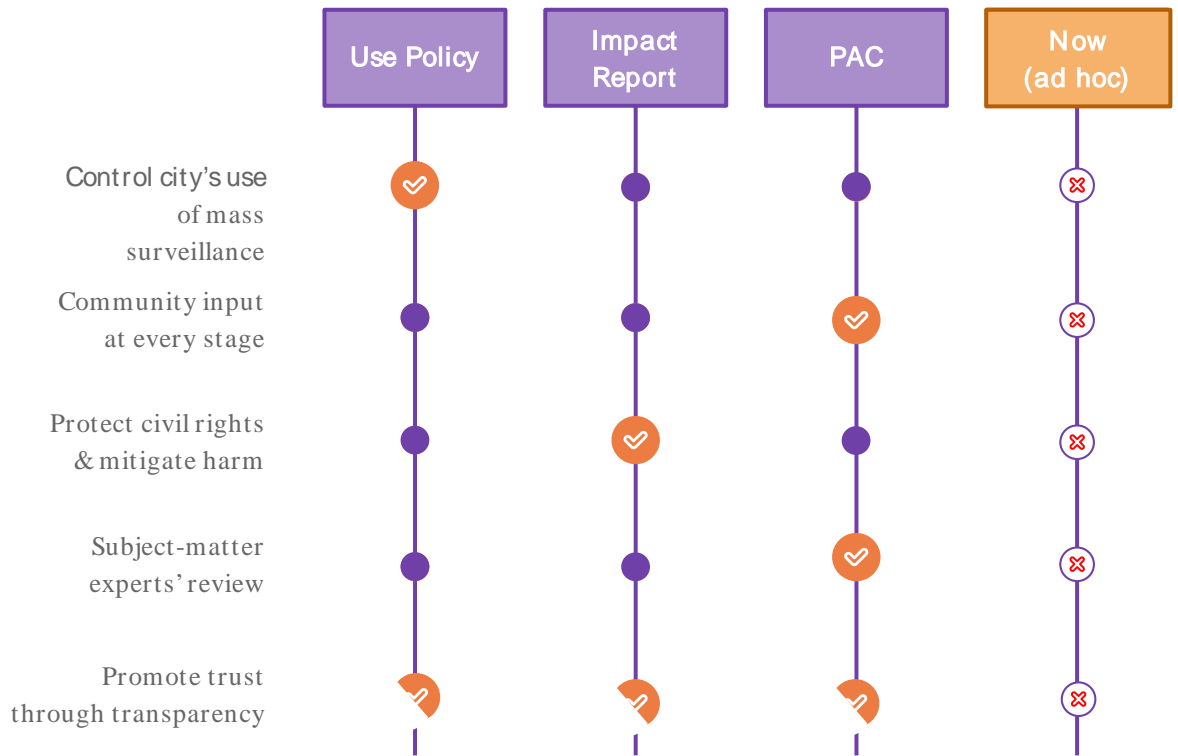
### With PAC

Annual check-ups for effectiveness & need.

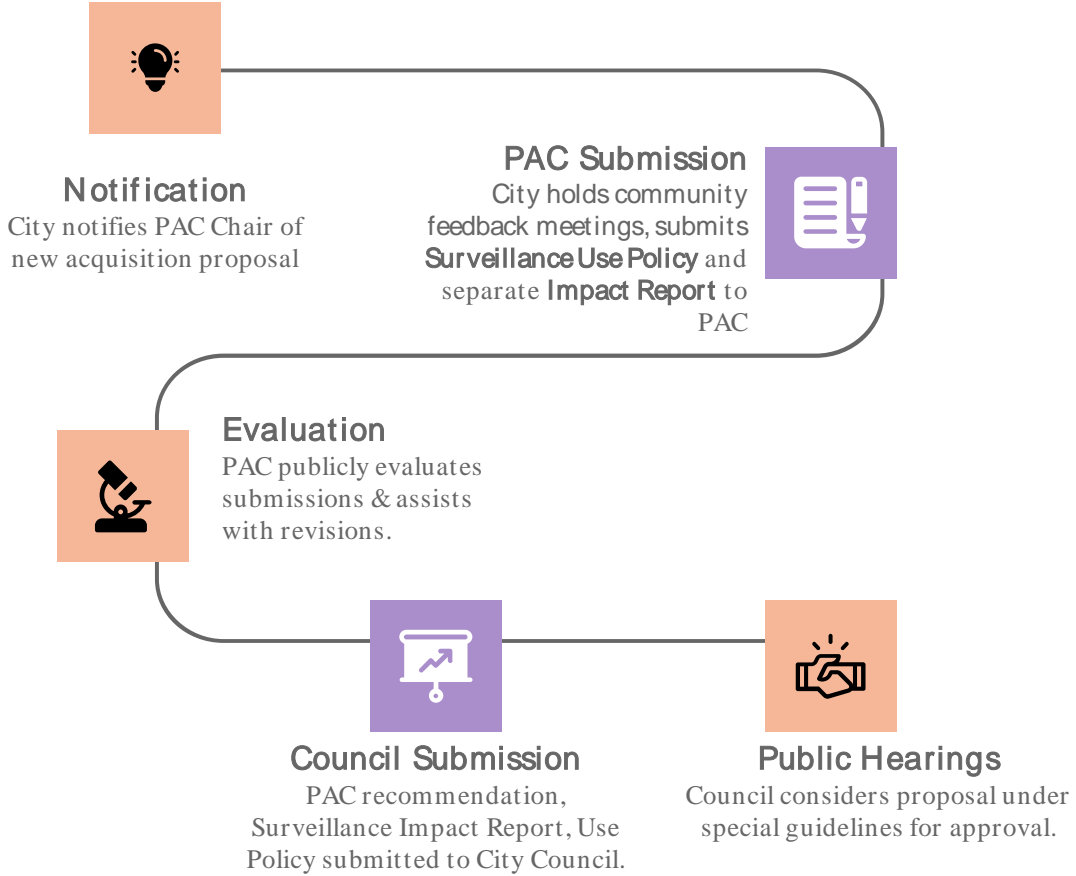

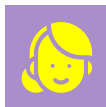
# Acquiring New Surveillance Technology
